INFILTRATION OF JUDAIZERS


- Message may have been similar to Acts 15:1
 - May have also relied heavily on an argument based on Abraham's circumcision
 - Claimed backing of Jerusalem: "All the believers there are circumcised and they are the home church of this movement. Perhaps Paul neglected to tell you this..."

NOTABLE FEATURES OF GALATIANS

- Paul's first letter in the canon of Scripture
- Missing a "Thanksgiving" at the beginning
- Best autobiographical sketch of Paul's earlier years
- Urgent appeal to his own converts not to 'fall from grace' (5:4)
- Theologically consistent with his later writings
- What can we learn about his ministry in Lystra from this letter?

HOW DID PAUL COME TO KNOW THE GOSPEL?

- I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it ...
- But I received it through a revelation ...
- Of Jesus Christ
- His conversion experience is primarily this revelation
 - What was the content?




DATING GALATIANS

- Acts and Galatians both have different chronological data, with some overlap, and require some degree of reconciling.
- Acts 11:27-30;12:25; ch. 15; Galatians 1-2
- Debate centers around:
 - Whether Paul wrote to the Northern or Southern Galatians
 - Whether Paul's visit to Jerusalem in Galatians 2 is his visit in Acts
 11:30 or Acts 15


LOCATING GALATIANS CHRONOLOGICALLY

- Read some arguments from Ben Witherington, III in his commentary on Acts, pp. 90ff.
- We place this likely before the Jerusalem Council in AD 49.

SONS OF ABRAHAM

- Galatians 3
 - The key to being sons of Abraham is hearing and believing, not keeping the Law
 - Under the Law, we are all under a curse
 - In Christ, we are redeemed from this curse and given the blessing of Abraham:
 - The Holy Spirit in us, which is how God is blessing the nations

SONS OF GOD (NOT SLAVES)

- Galatians 3:23-4:7
 - "Sons of God"
 - No longer under the Law / tutor
 - Abraham's descendants, heirs
 - Adopted, Spirit of His Son: "Abba!"
 - No longer slaves, but sons, heirs

BE FREE, AND DON'T FALL

- Galatians 5:1-6
 - Be free, not yoked with slavery
 - Circumcision obligates complete compliance with the Law, which we are incapable of.
 - Don't "fall from grace"
 - It's not about the outward appearance, but about faith working through love.

PAUL AND SILAS ARRIVE, DELIVERING THE RESULTS OF THE JERUSALEM COUNCIL

- Story?
- This puts an end to all the wondering about this issue, because both Paul [of the *Galatians* letter] and Silas [authorized by the Jerusalem Council to deliver the results] are there to authenticate this message.

AN APOSTOLIC INVITATION

- Faithfulness as a disciple was demonstrated
- "Well spoken of"
- Paul wanted him to join his team
- One small last detail
- Say goodbye, be willing
- This is in Paul's "Second Missionary Journey" It's Timothy's First.
