

SEEING WHAT GOD IS DOING


- Acts 16:9-10

- Lydia




"THESE MEN ARE THROWING OUR CITY INTO CONFUSION!"

- Roman justice, inappropriately administered
- Timothy sees, but is not persecuted himself.
 - Likely joins with Luke at Lydia's house to pray.
